WHY NIGER?

Niger is located in the Sahel, one of the harshest contexts in the world. It is prone to droughts, floods, political instability, and extremist violence. The prolonged dry season and very short rainy seasons deepen the water supply crisis, stressing not only food production and livelihood activities but also child and maternal health.

Charity: Water began working with World Vision in Niger in 2014, and is currently working in the Guidan Roundji Department (District) in the Maradi Region to reach full water and sanitation coverage in the Chadakori commune.

In this area of Niger, many people access their drinking water through unimproved sources, like unprotected open wells. Our partner is implementing new and rehabilitated drilled wells and mechanized piped water systems to bring clean, safe water to these rural communities. Given the low sanitation coverage rates in this area, effective sanitation and hygiene programming is especially important. To ensure sustainability and community ownership, community-led Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) committees are responsible for operating and maintaining WASH facilities, and communities also provide small financial contributions, labor, and materials for the water points.

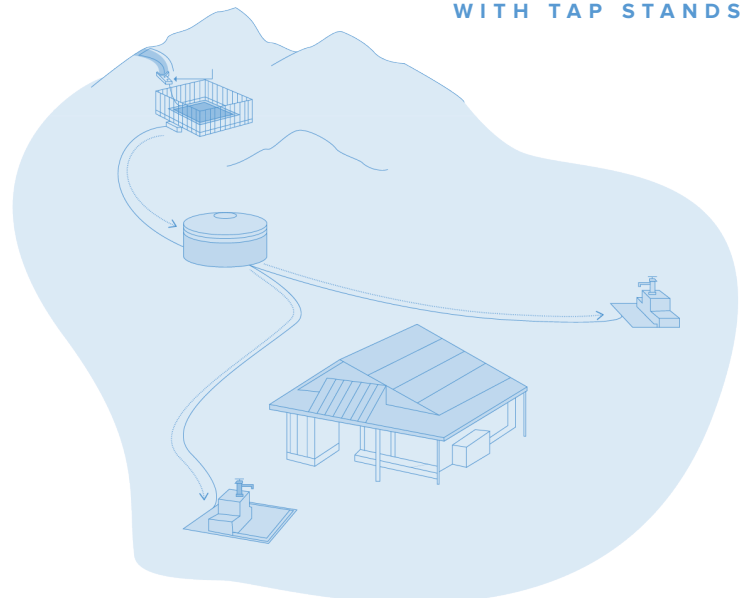

The piped systems in Niger access water using a borehole drilled deep into the ground with a submersible pump powered by solar panels. From the source, water is pumped into an elevated storage tank nearby. Through a pipeline network, water is distributed by gravity to individual tap stands located in one or more communities.

While piped system construction is typically more expensive than wells with hand pumps, the systems can significantly reduce time spent collecting water, as the water is piped directly to the community or household.

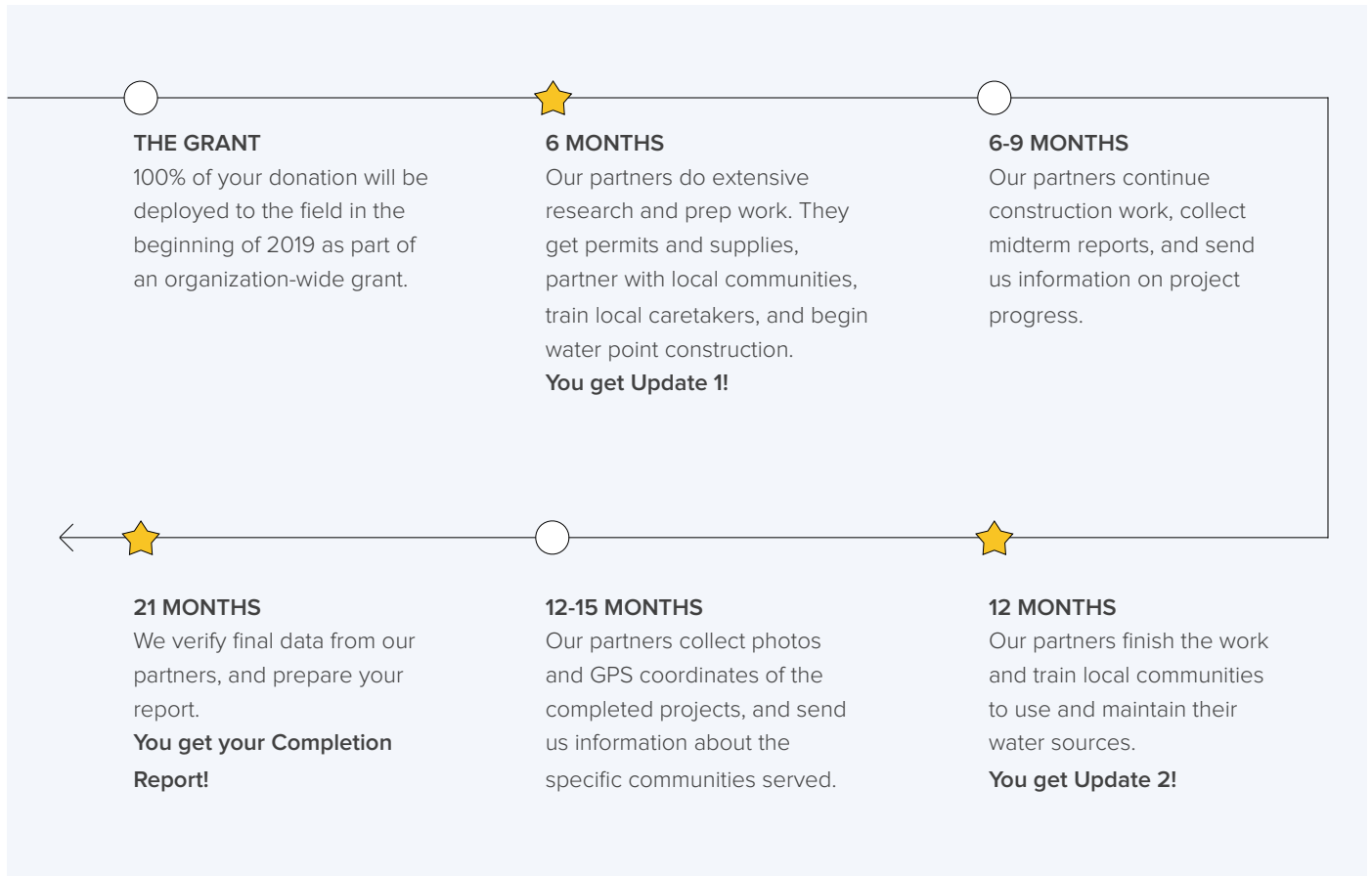
By sponsoring a piped system tap stand, you can provide access to clean and safe water for an entire community in Niger.
